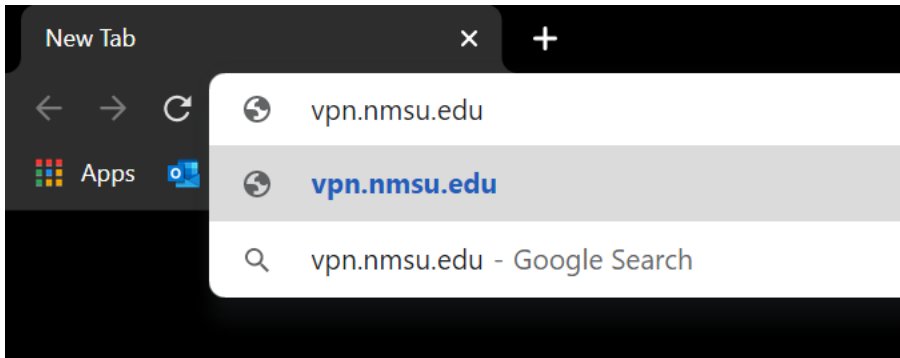
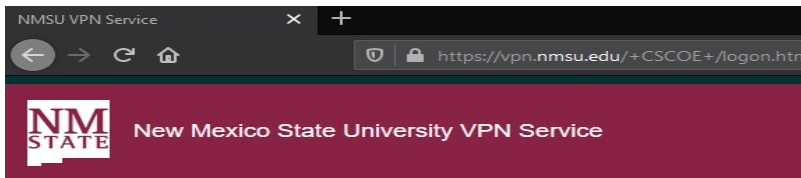


Using the NMSU VPN Service

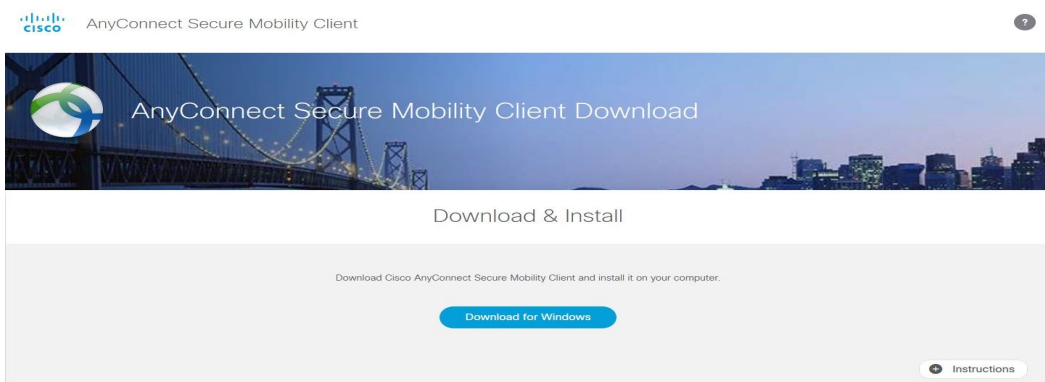
1. Open a web browser of your choice and enter “vpn.nmsu.edu” in the URL bar:



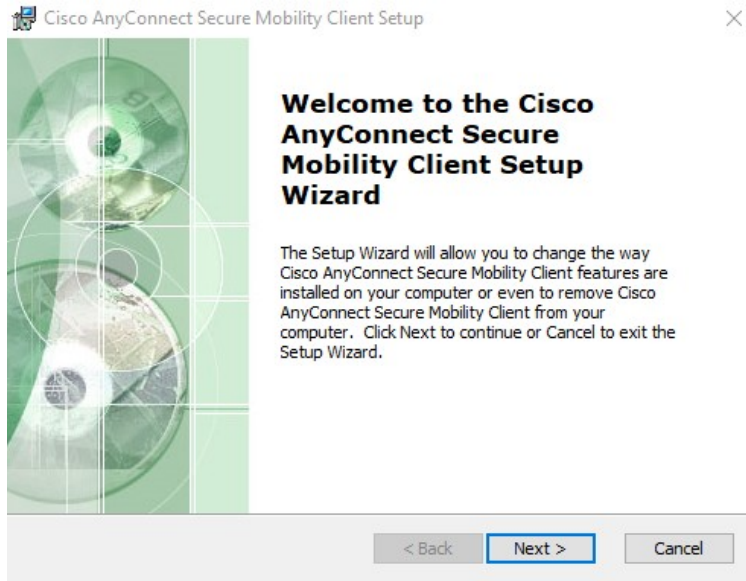
2. Navigate to the webpage and log in using your myNMSU username and password

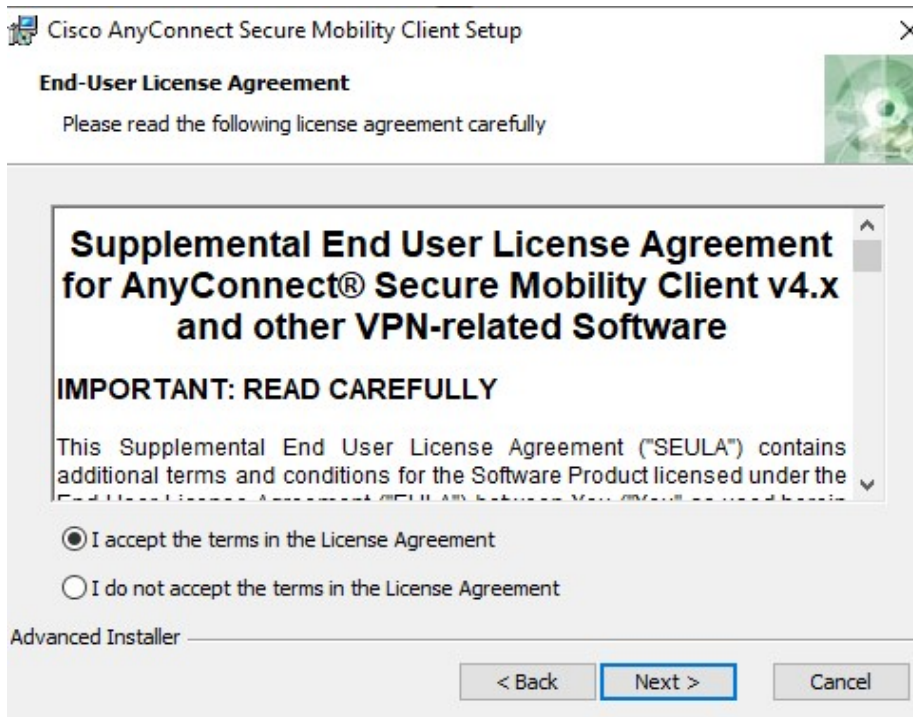
3. Click “Download for Windows”



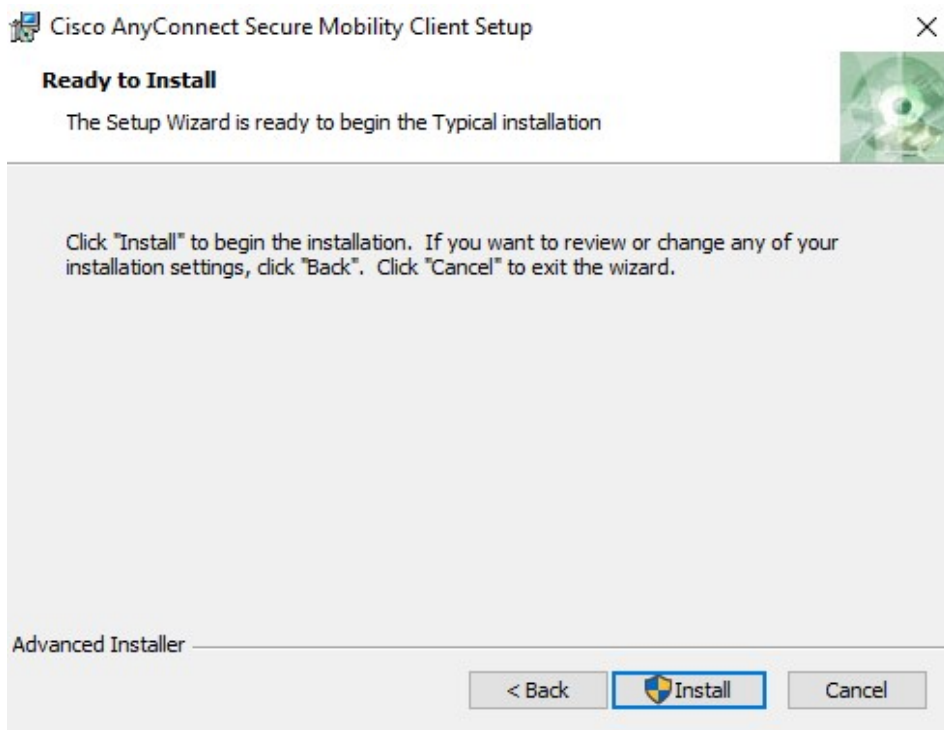
4. Run the “anyconnect-win-4.7.04056-core-vpn-webdeploy-k9.exe” file that you downloaded; the window that opens should look like this:



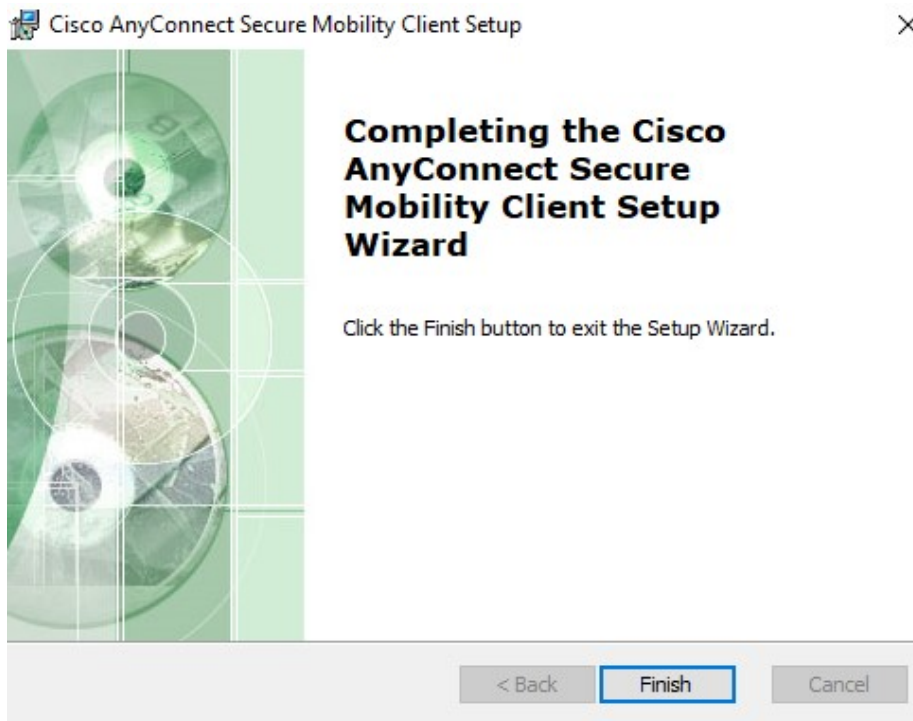
6. Select “I accept the terms in the License Agreement” and click next



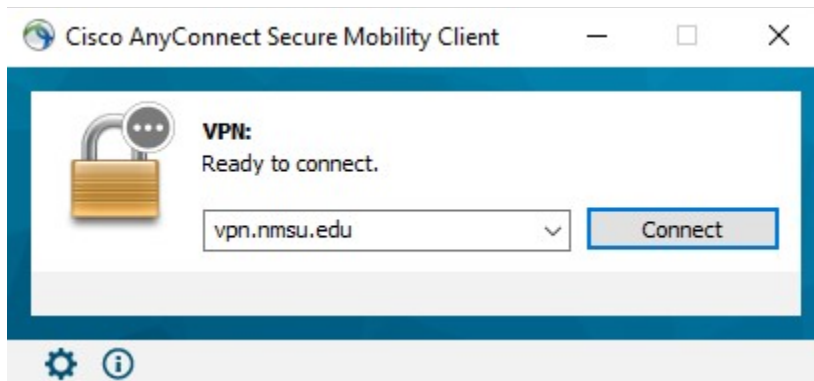
7. Click "Install"



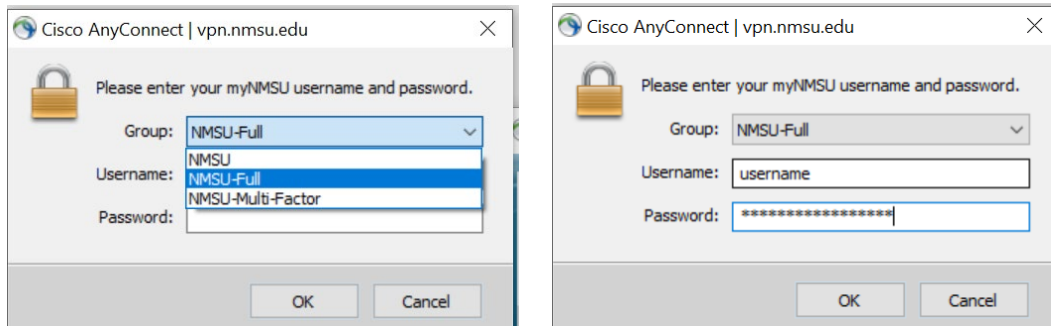
8. Click "Finish"



9. Launch the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client and type “vpn.nmsu.edu” in the “server address” field, then click connect:



10. Select your desired group – if you are unsure which to select, use “NMSU-Full”, then type in your myNMSU credentials (no “@nmsu.edu”) and click “OK”



11. If you see this window, you have connected successfully and will be able to use NMSU resources as if you were connected to an on-campus network.
